Light missionary travel

Last week we heard how Jesus was rejected in his hometown of Nazareth. This week's Gospel and the one for next week describe how Jesus sent the disciples to minister in his name and the disciples' return to Jesus afterward. Jesus sends out his disciples and commissions them to preach with his authority, to liberate, and heal. These are prophetic role. Jesus' disciples were ordinary men whom he sends for evangelization. He sends them on light journey. They are to submit themselves to the risk of hospitality: No bread, it will be provided for them; no haversack, no accommodation, they will be provided; and, for the same reason, no money. Sandals, yes, and a staff (as a walking stick, support in case of tiredness) because they will be constantly on the move. Those who receive the Good News, will be shared with missionaries sent by the Lord. Jesus himself depended on the hospitality of his followers in his ministry. If they do meet with inhospitality and rejection in any place, then they are to respond with a prophetic gesture indicating judgment (shaking the dust from under their feet; cf. Acts 13:51) and move on.
