The True Bread from Heaven.

This Sunday continues the theme of the bread of life. The readings show again God's loving care of the people. However, this Sunday this meaning of the feeding begins to unfold. The food that is given is not just bread from the earth; it is bread from heaven. We hear this in the first reading. The Gospel tells us that Jesus is the true bread from heaven. Neither the barley loaves nor the food that God supplied in the wilderness will permanently satisfy us. The effects of the bread that Jesus gives will endure for eternal life. It is the faith in Jesus that will satisfy our deepest hunger, and we will not be able to survive apart from him.

As you will be aware the Government have announced their intention to lift Covid-19 restrictions in England from Monday 19th July.

We have been carefully considering our position given that there has been an increase in Covid-19 positive cases in Watford & Abbots Langley over the last few weeks which no doubt you will be aware, has affected many local schools.

So that we can keep our community safe, particularly those who are elderly and more vulnerable, we have taken the decision to ask Parishioners to continue using the sanitiser stations when entering the Church and continue wearing face coverings unless you have a medical exemption. We will continue to ask that people wear face coverings until 23rd August when we will review the situation again.
