As you will be aware the Government announced the lifting off all Covid-19 restrictions in England from Monday 19th July.

Now the Government has issued further guidance in relation to Covid-19 measures and procedures linked to offering 16-18 years old the vaccine. This links to reducing social distancing measures further. Starting next week, we will review some measures in our Parish-Church.
