Confessions: Priests will be available in the Confessional on Saturdays 6:20pm to 6:50pm. Weekdays: Tuesday to Friday from 9:15am to 9:55am. You can also book an appointment with the priest for confession for a time that is convenient to you.

Rosary: The Rosary will be said every Friday after the 10am mass.

Our Lady of Peace Prayer Group meets every Friday at 7pm in the church. All are welcome.

The Spiritan's Provincial Superior of the British Province is celebrating all the masses this weekend masses during his first visit to our parish.

First Sunday of Advent: The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. The first purple candle, which we light today, symbolizes hope. It is sometimes called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, especially Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ. It represents the expectation felt in anticipation of the coming Messiah.

Confirmation: There will be a meeting for Parents on Tuesday 29th November at 7pm in the Parish hall. Please do not miss this meeting.

Acton Homeless Concern: A member of Acton Homeless Concern will be coming to make an appeal at all masses on 5/6th December. The second collection on 10/11th December will be for Acton Homeless Concern.

Christmas Masses: There will be a Children's mass on Christmas Eve at 6pm—all children and families are welcome. There will also be a Midnight Mass with a Carol Service beforehand at 11.30am. Sunday masses will remain the same at 9am, 10.30am and 12pm.

Giving Tree: We will be displaying the Giving Tree again this year. Please take a tag, buy the items on the tag and drop it into the parish office. Gift/care packages will be put together for the homeless and those in need by volunteers and Acton Homeless Concern.

If you have never been baptized, if you were baptized in another Christian denomination and would like to become Catholic, or if you were baptized Catholic, but never received the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation, you are welcome to join the RCIA programme, the process by which adults become Catholic. Likewise, if you are Catholic and interested in learning more about the Faith.

Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS – so that there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH.

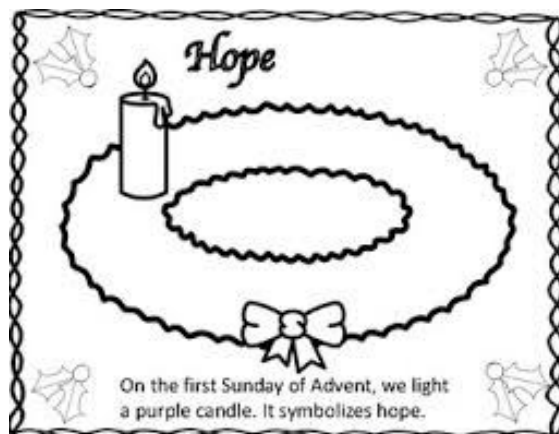
STREET COLLECTION HELP SATURDAY 10th DECEMBER
