~ SACRAMENTS IN OUR PARISH ~

We have ~40 young people preparing for First Holy Communion, ~68 young people preparing for Confirmation and several adults preparing for Reception into the Catholic Faith. Please keep all of them in your prayers.

First Holy Communion: Children need to attend classes every Saturday during term time.

Confirmation: Sessions are normally on Mondays from 7-8pm in the hall. Except for school holidays.

RCIA: Our meetings for RCIA candidates are on Thursdays at 7pm in the hall. Please contact the office if you would like to join.

Baptism for babies and infants Please attend one of the weekend Masses and speak with Fr. Patrick/Fr Jude afterwards. They will advise you on how to proceed.

Marriage Preparation & Support

If you are thinking about getting married please get in touch with a priest very early in the process. Couples are required to give 6 months notice of marriage – whether it is taking place here or abroad. Please do not leave it to last minute. Call the parish office to arrange a meeting with the priest if you are preparing for marriage or if you are a married couple would like or need support.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) Journey in Faith: Are You Interested in Becoming a Catholic?

If you have never been baptised, if you were baptised in another Christian denomination or if you were baptised Catholic but never received the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation, and would like to become Catholic, you are very welcome to join the RCIA programme, the process by which adults become Catholic. Likewise, any Catholic interested in learning more about the Faith is welcome to join too.
