Good Shepherd Sunday and Priest Training Fund Retiring Collection

This Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Easter, is often called Good Shepherd Sunday as the Gospel reading **refers to Jesus's description of himself as the Good Shepherd. Appropriately, it is the Sunday when we** pray for vocations to the priesthood, that the Lord will raise up priests to act as good shepherds for us in the ordained ministry, and also when the annual collection for the Priest Training Fund takes place, and so there will be a retiring collection this Sunday for this fund. The fund pays for the priestly formation of those training for the priesthood in our diocese. There are currently thirteen in formation at our diocesan seminary, Allen Hall, with a further seminarian at the Royal English College in Valladolid, Spain, and one at the Pontifical Beda College in Rome. Three were ordained as deacons last year who will go on to ordination as priests this summer. Seminary formation now takes at least seven years and the Priest Training Fund also supports the ongoing formation of those already ordained as priests. Donation envelopes are available at the back of the church, which you can use this Sunday or else take away and bring back. You can also use the envelope to gift aid your donation if you are a UK income tax payer. Please do pray for vocations to the priesthood at this time. Thank you for your generosity in supporting this important annual collection.
