Dear Parishioner

May I take this opportunity to wish you a blessed and healthy Christmas and New Year.

As a parish, we have been through turbulent times and I thought it would be good to give thanks to the Lord for His continued blessings in our lives and in our parish. It is wonderful for us to come together to celebrate Christmas, the birth of our Saviour, and I believe the Lord is teaching us how to rely and depend on Him more and more each day.

Throughout these recent months, the good news of Jesus is being proclaimed and we have been blessed with reaching out to children, families and the elderly within our parish. We currently have a number of children attending Saturday RE Classes; together with a lively Baptism Class; thirty five children preparing for the Sacrament of Holy Communion; twenty five year 9 and twenty year 10 students preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation and amazingly ten adults attending the RCIA flowing from recent 'Alpha' courses. (This is a wonderful response considering the pandemic).

Slowly parish life is recovering and groups are gathering once again. Our finance team continued serving our parish throughout the pandemic. We now have an active Pastoral Forum; please see the noticeboard or parish website for information. It is great to see the 'Life Ascending' group meeting regularly, which continues to be a wonderful support to the senior members of the parish. We also have a number of parish Prayer Cell groups and men's prayer groups. We have a number of independent groups back in our hall, such as CancerLink and Guiding, and we look forward to the other groups restarting, such as the parents and toddlers and youth clubs, in the new year.
