

The image of the shepherd, as we have in this Sunday's readings, is one of the most enduring in the Bible. This is not the Western shepherd, who sometimes use dogs and pens to force the sheep where he wants them, but the Eastern shepherd, who leads his flock alone, spending all his days and nights with them, devoting the whole of his life to being with the flock he loves.

The hymn, "Shepherd-King o'er mountain steep, homeward guide thy wand'ring sheep," captures the readings perfectly: our King is not a cruel tyrant or despot, but a shepherd who loves his flock, who would (and did) give his life for them. Love for the flock means that he will have to judge them, separating the sheep from those who do not belong to him.

Coming to the end of the Church's year leads us to look to our final ending, the homecoming the hymn speaks of. The judgement of the end of time we do not view as a court trial or a terror, but as a coming home to give account of our stewardship to God. All we need do therefore is put our lives in order, living just and holy lives, longing for the Day of the Lord to come.
