

✤ Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord, Year B, 31st March 2024

EASTER MESSAGE

"For our sake God made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God." (2 Corinthians 5:21)

God's interest and care for us is so incredible that it prompted the psalmist to ask God: "What is man that you should keep him in mind, mortal man that you care for him? Yet you have made him little less than a god; with glory and honour you crowned him..." (Psalm 8:4-9) This utter wonder as the psalmist contemplated the marvel and the beauty in God's creation, has since been surpassed by the Easter story. God, through the life, passion and death of his Son Jesus Christ, has shown us how much more we are worth and the value he attaches to us as his children. God gave his Son Jesus Christ to die on the Cross to save us from our sins and from eternal damnation. One word that best answers the psalmist's question is LOVE – God's unconditional love for humanity.

In different ways we see a witness to and participation in God's sacrificial love of God in the ways our parishioners reach out to and look after other parishioners, visiting the sick, bringing comfort to the bereaved, responding to appeals to help out in different ways, whether it be in our life as worshipping community or social life as a parish community. It is so inspiring to hear parishioners talk about the support they receive from other parishioners. These and many more good things that are happening in our parish community are so because of the Easter story.

Of course, the trophy is yet to be won. As the love of Christ continues to urge us on, let us press forward all the more eargerly with deeds of Christ-centred love so that we may win the prize for which Christ died for us. Therefore, as the Easter People redeemed by the precious Blood of Christ, let us continue to spread this selfless and sacrificial love in a world that is in so much need of love to heal the wounds of war and division.

Right to Life – Please support an amendment to reduce our abortion law from 24 weeks to 22 weeks. Babies born prematurely at 22 weeks are thriving and there is a contradiction in our abortion law. In one room of a hospital, doctors could be working to save a baby born alive at 22 or 23 weeks, whilst, in another room of the same hospital, a doctor could perform an abortion that would end the life a baby at the same age. ComRes Poll shows that 70% of British women favour a reduction in the limit from 24 weeks to 20 weeks or below.
