

"They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak foreign languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech. We hear them preaching in our own language about the marvels of God." (Acts. 2:4; 11)

Pentecost was one of the three pilgrimage feasts of Judaism. (Ex 23:16; 34:12; Lev 23:15-21; Dt. 16:9-12). It was an important harvest feast as we see from Paul's eagerness to be in Jerusalem for it (Acts 20:16). In the Old Dispensation, the Israelites on this feast presented the first fruits of their wheat harvest and offered thanksgiving to God.

In the Christian Dispensation, Pentecost – fifty days after Easter Sunday – is now associated with the event of the descent of Holy Spirit on the Apostles and the birth of the early Christian church. This event fulfils the promise of the Advocate made by Jesus to his disciples in the **Gospel reading.** (Jn. 15:26-27,16:12-15) One of the many significance of this dramatic event as St Luke gives account of it in the **first reading** (Acts. 2:1-11), is that the Gospel message "speaks" to every human heart. Thus, differences in language, race, colour, times or creed are no barriers to God when, where and how he chooses to continue to reveal himself so that the whole human race may continue to receive the benefits of Christ death and resurrection.

In celebrating this feast today, we give thanks to God for our new birth in the Church through the instrumentality of the Holy Spirit. The implication therefore is that our lives should reflect the harvest of the fruits of the Spirit as the St Paul enjoins the Christian communion in the **second reading.** (Gal. 5:16-25) To keep the flame of the Spirit aglow, we also have to distance ourselves from the works of self-indulgence and every immoral acts. We can ask for the help of this same Spirit in the words of the **Psalmist**: 'Lord, send out your Spirit and renew the face of the earth'.

As we are called to witness to the fire of God (by bringing the light of the Son and the heat of the Spirit to all we meet), let's pray this line of St Paul every day this coming week: 'Since the Spirit is my life, let me be directed by the Spirit.'

On this feast of Pentecost, we wish everyone a happy birthday in the Church!
