"THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS"

A 'Religiously coded' catechism song when Roman Catholics in England were not permitted to practice their faith openly. The "True Love" one hears in the song is Jesus Christ. The partridge in the pear tree also represents Him because that bird is willing to sacrifice its life to protect its young.

The two turtle doves were the Old and New Testaments The three French hens stood for faith, hope, and love The four calling birds - Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke& John. The five golden rings - the first five books of the Old

Testament, describing man's fall into sin and the great love of God in sending a Saviour.

The six geese a-laying - the six days of creation. Seven swans a-swimming - gifts of the Holy Spirit-Prophesy, Serving, Teaching, Exhortation, Contribution, Leadership, and Mercy.

The eight maids a-milking were the eight beatitudes Nine ladies dancing - the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness Mildness, Fidelity, Modesty, Chastity

The ten Lords a-leaping were the Ten Commandments. The eleven pipers piping - the eleven faithful Apostles. The twelve drummers drumming- the twelve points of belief in The Apostles' Creed.
