ST JOSEPH'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL Public consultation on draft Admission Policy 2019-2020-This policy sets out the arrangements for applying for a place in the School. St Joseph's has made some minor changes to its admissions policy for September 2019 and wishes to consult parishioners about the revised policy. The main change is to include Catholic children from Gilston and Eastwick parishes in the list of those who will be given priority if places are oversubscribed. This is because the local authority has pointed out that St Joseph's is the nearest Catholic Primary School for them in Hertfordshire They will be ranked **after** children of the Catholic Parish of Bishop's Stortford.
