WESTMINSTER YEAR BOOKS available now from the office £5 each. YEMEN CRISIS - Advent is a time of prayer and reflection as we look forward to celebrating the birth of Christ. We especially ask over the coming weeks that you remember the people of Yemen. The civil war between the Houthi ethnic group and supporters of Yemen's government is now into its second year. The UN estimates that the conflict has killed more than 10,000 people, with 6,000 people killed this year alone. More than 7 million in Yemen do not know where their next meal will come from. CAFOD's partner in Yemen is providing humanitarian assistance in the form of food, water, medical care and shelter. You can find updates on the situation on the CAFOD website and you can donate online or send in donations to CAFOD, which will be used towards responding to this crisis.
