

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS - GDPR



The new law around data protection (GDPR) came into force on Friday 25 May, 2018. Following instructions from the Diocese we have therefore updated all of our processes which include new confidentiality agreements for all volunteers and privacy statements on all documentation. The GDPR states that we must;

- Keep personal data secure
- Only use personal data for the purpose collected

Diocese of Westminster Charity No. 233699

- Only keep personal data for as long as needed, ensure it is kept accurate and up to date.
- Securely delete or destroy personal data when no longer needed
- Don't give out personal data to third parties.

As a volunteer in the parish who generously gives their time and talents you may come across sensitive information that we need to protect so:-

- Rotas that are published for display in the Church or on the Parish web site must contain a name only.
- Each Rota has to carry a 'Privacy notice' advising volunteers on the specific rota that their details will be shared with fellow volunteers on the same rota to enable you to arrange cover and if you do not wish your personal details to be shared to let the 'Organiser of the Rota' or the Parish Priest know'. Consent can be withdrawn at any time. Rotas containing personal contact details should be kept secure in a locked cabinet. If kept electronically should be password protected
- Rotas will run for a specific period and so paper copies should be securely destroyed using a 'shredder' and not put in a paper recycling bin. Electronic copies should be deleted from the computer and then deleted from the deleted items within one month after the end of the rota period.
- Contact details should only be shared with those on the rota for the purpose of arranging cover.
- Please read sign & return a 'Confidentiality agreement' (available in the Sacristy) if you are a parish volunteer and receive access to personal data via a rota or any other means.
- If you use your own computer equipment for parish work you are required to have the permission of the Parish Priest and asked to please sign a Parish Computer Code of Practice and return to Fr Peter.
