NOTES:

- 1. In Lack of Form cases no date should be set until the Declaration of Freedom is received from the Chancery.
- 2. All Convalidations should be referred to the Chancery Office with a copy of the civil marriage certificate.
- 3. Where a person wishing to marry is a Catholic, but **not of the Latin Rite**, references should always be made to the Chancery Office before arrangements are made for the wedding.
- 4. After the marriage, it is the responsibility of the priest/deacon to see a **notification** of the celebration of this marriage is sent to the church of baptism of the Catholic party/parties.
- 5. This **marriage dossier** is to be carefully preserved in the archives of the parish where this marriage is celebrated, except in the cases of Dispensations from Canonical Form (non-Catholic Church) marriages, where it is to be kept in the parish of the priest / deacon applying for the Dispensation.
- 6. A £30 offering is suggested for all marriage cases processed through the Chancery Office.
