

Gospel Reflection

In our Gospel today, Jesus appoints seventy-two others to go out on the road before him to all the places he was to visit on his final journey to Jerusalem. Their message is to be that the kingdom of God is very near.

For the 72, the kingdom of God was of course very near in the person and mission of Jesus; but by virtue of our Baptism and strengthened by Confirmation, each one of us is also sent out by Jesus to proclaim the kingdom of God. Every time we say the Our Father, the prayer that Jesus taught us, we pray that God's kingdom will come. The kingdom of God is established wherever God reigns, wherever God's will is done. The kingdom of God is present when people act in God's name. Supremely, God reigns in Jesus, the fullest expression of God's will. To proclaim the kingdom of God is to proclaim Christ.

The kingdom of God comes upon us when God reigns in our hearts, when God's will is done in us, when God acts through us.

By sending his disciples out with no purse, nor haversack nor sandals, Jesus was urging them to rely totally on God's power to assist them in their mission. We may be sure that God's power is always with us when we work for the coming of his kingdom. As St Paul promised, God through his power working in us, is able to accomplish immeasurably more than all we can ask for, or even imagine.

"The Kingdom of God is where our best dreams come from and our truest prayers. We glimpse it at those moments when we find ourselves being better than we are and wiser than we know. We catch sight of it when at some moment of crisis a strength seems to come to us that is greater than our own strength. The Kingdom of God is where we belong. It is home". (Frederick Buechner)

WORLD YOUTH DAY 2023 – LOOKING TO LISBON

World Youth Day 2023 will take place in Lisbon in the beginning of August 2023.
