Drop down dew from above, you heavens, **Entrance Antiphon:** 

and let the clouds rain down the Just One;

let the earth be opened and bring forth a Saviour.

He is the king of glory.

**Gospel Acclamation:** Alleluia, alleluia!

The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son

and they will call him Emmanuel, a name which means 'God-is-with-us'.

Alleluia!

Mary had to face an enormous challenge to her faith and trust in God: so too did Joseph, the man she chose to marry. It had never been heard of before that a child could be born without a natural father. Mary was asked to accept this miraculous exception to the laws of nature. Mary was not yet married. Pregnancy outside of wedlock was not tolerated in those days. Mary was only betrothed or engaged to Joseph and this was expected to last for a whole year. Mary's extraordinary pregnancy could have led to her being rejected by Joseph, by her family, by all her own people. She nonetheless believed and trusted in God.

Joseph, a just and God-fearing man, did not wish to embarrass or punish Mary when he discovered that she was pregnant. To all appearances she had broken their solemn pledge to be faithful and chaste to one another. Joseph no doubt took this troubling matter to God in prayer. He was not hasty to judge or to react with hurt and anger. God rewarded him not only with guidance and consolation, but with the divine assurance that he had indeed called Joseph to be the husband of Mary and to assume a mission that would require the utmost faith, confidence, and trust in Almighty God. Joseph accepted the angel of the Lord's advice to take Mary as his wife and to accept the child in her womb as the promised Messiah.

Like Mary, Joseph is a model of faith for us. He is a faithful witness and servant of God's unfolding plan of redemption. God has a plan for each one of us. Like Joseph we may find our faith and trust in God challenged by perplexing circumstances and what seems like insurmountable problems. God never leaves us alone, and has sent us his only begotten Son, our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As we look forward to Christmas, the feast of the Incarnation, with joyful hearts let us renew our faith and trust in God and in his redeeming work.
