

Liturgy of the Word: 5th February 2023

Entrance Antiphon: O come, let us worship God

and bow low before the God who made us,

for he is the Lord our God.

Next week's Readings: Eccles.15:15-20, Psalm 118, I Corinthians 2: 6-10, Matthew 5: 20-37

"You are the light of the world – you are the salt of the earth". These words of Jesus in our Gospel today are not addressed privately to the group of his twelve apostles. They are directed instead to all his disciples gathered to listen to him preach what we know as his Sermon on the Mount. That this is the case is underlined by the fact that in today's liturgy the Church links this Gospel passage to the first reading from the Prophet Isaiah. There the Lord, speaking through his prophet, addressed not just a special group but the whole people of Israel. "Your light must shine like the dawn – your light must rise in the darkness."

This means of course that as disciples of Jesus, we are meant to hear these words as being addressed directly to us, both as individuals, but also as a community of faith. We together are called to be salt for the people of our time. We are called to be present in the midst of our society as a community of faith which preserves the integrity and wholeness of our community, just as salt preserves food from decay. We are meant to be, like salt added to food, a presence which brings out the best in our society. And we are meant to be like a light shining in the darkness of our society, helping people to find their way to the fullness of life God so deeply desires for all his children.

This is a responsibility we all share as brothers and sisters in Christ. It is the task we have been given by the Lord who has called us into his Church so that together we can be a clear, living and attractive sign of the ongoing presence of Jesus in our world today.

"Continue to walk in the faith, and faithful to the mandate that has been entrusted to you, go out with solicitude and joy to all creatures and pass on to them the gift of salvation. . . . be guided by the Holy Spirit to be the leaven of new life, salt of the earth and light of the world." Pope Benedict

Petition to stop the introduction of abortion up to birth

In 2021, abortion campaigners brought forward an amendment to a Government Bill that would have introduced abortion on demand, for any reason, up to birth (including sex-selective abortion).

This amendment did not go to a vote and pass, but the abortion lobby is expected to make another attempt to introduce this extreme abortion law change shortly. This would be the single biggest change to abortion legislation since 1967 and would introduce one of the most extreme abortion laws in the world.
