 Liturgy of the Word: 26th March 2023 Give me justice, O God, and plead my cause against a nation that is faithless. From the deceitful and cunning rescue me, for you, O God, are my strength . Jesus' raising of his friend Lazarus, who has been dead for four days, is the last and the greatest of the seven miracles or 'signs' in John's Gospel. After this event no further miracles are recorded by John until the Lord's own Resurrection. The 'sign' of Lazarus serves to prepare people for the coming death of Jesus and to point to his conquest over death in the Resurrection.

Lazurus' sister Mary, who had on another occasion anointed the feet of Jesus and wiped them with her own hair, now prostrates herself once again at his feet and declares: 'Lord, if you had been here my brother would not have died.' Jesus had delayed for two days after hearing that Lazarus was ill before setting out to visit the family. Similarly, some of the onlookers wonder: 'He opened the eyes of the blind man, could he not have prevented this man's death ?' Lazarus' other sister Martha, similarly challenges Jesus that if he had come earlier, her brother would not have died, but adds that she knows that "even now" God will grant Jesus anything he asks. She expresses her faith that her brother will rise again at the last day, but at the command of the Lord, Lazarus is restored to life there and then.

By raising Lazarus, Jesus displays the power over death which he will manifest in his own resurrection: in less than eight days Jesus will be crucified and rise from the dead. Many of the people who had witnessed the death and resurrection of Lazarus would experience the death and resurrection of Christ. For those who might doubt that Jesus' Resurrection of was real, or was some kind of stunt, they had, within their recent memory, seen it happen to Lazarus, so they would know it was possible.

Jesus promises us that death is not the end for us and for our loved ones: 'Anyone who believes in me, even though they die, yet shall they live'.
