Liturgy of the Word: 19th February 2023

**Entrance Antiphon:** O Lord, I trust in your merciful love.

My heart will rejoice in your salvation.

I will sing to the Lord who has been bountiful with me.

**Responsorial Psalm:** The Lord is compassion and love.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia!

If anyone loves me he will keep my word,

and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him.

Next week's Readings: Genesis 2:7-9, 3:1-7, Psalm 50, Romans 5:12, 17-19, Matthew 4: 1-11

"An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth" summarized ancient Israel's concept of reasonable retaliation for injury. It was a guideline for those administering justice that retribution should be proportionate: punishment should fit the crime but not be excessive.

Jesus has an altogether more creative response to dealing with the bad acts of others: he wants to overcome evil with good.

"Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God, am holy." This is how Moses speaks to the people of Israel in the name of God, continuing: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself."

Be holy and love. The people of God in every age belong to God, and we are called to put his love into practice by loving our neighbour.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus demands a higher standard from those who follow him: "love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you". We are not to make distinctions between ourselves and those who are neighbours or enemies: belonging to God, who loves us, we are to love everyone.

Jesus asks us to aim as high as possible: to seek to be perfect, just as our heavenly Father is perfect. We are the temple of God and the Spirit of God dwells in us: we are created to be perfect and holy.

As we look to the Father, responding to his love, we discover who we are. The law that has been written for us is written into our hearts by the Spirit, who allows us to share in the very life of Christ as we continue our earthly journey.

The beginning of Lent this Ash Wednesday gives us an ideal opportunity to focus our hearts on sharing in Christ's life as we prepare for the celebration of his passion and resurrection.

As God's people, called to be holy, to love and to aim for perfection in the image of the merciful God, we are asked to allow God to take up residence among us, to be the living signs of his presence in the world.
