

Entrance Antiphon: O Lord, hear my voice, for I have called to you;

In these days between the Ascension and Pentecost, the Church offers for our meditation the 17th Chapter of St. John's Gospel. Jesus raises his eyes to heaven and we are privileged eavesdroppers on the prayer he makes to the Father. This has been called the High Priestly prayer. Jesus, the greatest intermediary between God and humanity, prays for his beloved followers. In the light of the mystery of the Ascension, Jesus' prayer points towards our heavenly destiny, and as we pray for the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, we hope to build God's kingdom on earth as it is in heaven.

Jesus is glorified when he ascends to his Father's right hand, after his resurrection from the dead. Jesus asks that, through our union with him, through our belonging to him, we may be caught up into that glory.

The Holy Spirit is the glory of the Father and the Son. The Holy Spirit dwelling within us shares with us the glory of the Trinity. By the Holy Spirit even on earth we share the divine life. The Holy Spirit promises us that we will enter the life of the world to come.

To know God; to glorify God; to enter God's own glory; to receive eternal life, divine life; to participate in the mutual love of the Trinity: this is Heaven. It is also the meaning of the Christian life on earth. Through faith, hope and love all the baptized are called to build the kingdom on earth in a way that points to the peace and joy of heaven. This is the meaning of the Church's liturgy, and supremely of the Mass in which we are united with Jesus' timeless sacrifice and are joined by all the powers of heaven as this world and the next, in one voice cry out, holy, holy!
