"The bread that we break is a communion with the body of Christ" (I Cor 10:16)

On Holy Thursday we recalled the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. Today's Solemnity, kept in many countries last Thursday, is an opportunity to commemorate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ and to rejoice in this Sacrament which is the source and summit of the life of the Church. Throughout the world, Eucharistic processions take place as public acts of worship and adoration bear witness to the risen Christ, who walks amongst us and leads all people to heaven.

We call the Eucharist 'Holy Communion' because it enables us to enter into the life of Jesus: we enter into a communion with God through Jesus, who became human so that we might become divine. In his Body and Blood, Jesus unites us with Himself and confirms us in communion with each other, the mystical Body of Christ.

The Sacrament unites us with those in Church around us, with those sharing in Jesus' Body and Blood throughout the world, and with the whole of God's creation. The constant presence of the love of Jesus for us -a love which is boundless - makes its home in us and asks us to love as He has loved. It opens our eyes to see our brothers and sisters who are suffering, who are sick, who are hungry or homeless, as members of the same body of Christ. The Sacrament is not to be reserved for the sacred space of the Mass alone, but transforms us to be sent out into the world on mission. We go forth to show the love of Christ in service to others.

"I held the Host with two fingers and thought: how small Jesus made Himself, in order to show us that He doesn't expect great things of us, but rather little things with great love." (St Teresa of Calcutta)
