The season of Advent brings us hope, reminding us that God loves us, has sent his Son to redeem us, and that no one is excluded from God's loving care and protection.

As we begin a new liturgical year with this first Sunday of Advent, we are invited to take to heart the words of Jesus in today's Gospel: "Be on your guard. Stay awake"! We are asked to make the most of the opportunities presented us to each day. We can especially draw near to the Lord in prayer and in the reception of the Sacraments, by being of service to others; those near and dear to us and those who are strangers.

Advent reminds us of our human potential, of fully receiving the Lord into our lives, and to our destiny of being perfectly happy in the Kingdom of God. The primary focus of Advent is on the coming of God in human form in the person of Jesus Christ. He came two millennia ago; but he comes to us each day, and will come at the end of our lives, and at the end of the ages.

Advent is a time to revive what might be dormant within us, restoring our optimism and strengthening our hope. The beautiful words of the prophet Isaiah today enlighten our minds and our hearts, when the prophet prays to God: "Oh, that you would tear the heavens open and come down." That is exactly what our God has done and is doing for us. It is cause for great joy! This is what we celebrate in this season of Advent, which at its root is about the coming of Christ.

In Jesus' gospel story, the servants are warned to be ready for the master's return: "Do not let him come suddenly and catch you asleep." May we await the Lord's coming with prayer and patience, enthusiasm and doing our best, persevering in the call daily to know, love and serve the Lord and our neighbour.
