Liturgy of the Word: 4th February 2024

**Entrance Antiphon**: O come, let us worship God

and bow low before the God who made us,

for he is the Lord our God.

Next week's Readings: Leviticus 13:1-2, 44-46, Psalm 31 | Corinthians 10:31-11:1, Mark 1:40-45

Today we continue to listen to Mark's Gospel, learning more about the ministry of Jesus. Jesus cures Simon's mother-in-law, and she immediately begins to serve him and his disciples. Jesus also cured many others who were brought to him, healing their illnesses and driving out demons. As we will see throughout Mark's Gospel, Jesus did not permit the demons to speak because they knew his identity and would have revealed it to those who were present.

Very early in the morning after this busy day, Jesus takes himself off to a lonely place to pray, but was pursued by Simon and others who brought news that many people were looking for him. At this point in Mark's Gospel, we begin to see a distinct role for the inner circle of Jesus' disciples—they act as intermediaries between Jesus and the people. Jesus reports to his disciples that they need to leave Capernaum to preach in other places.

Today's Gospel completes a picture of Jesus' ministry: preaching, curing the sick, driving out demons, and then moving on to continue this work in another place. Mark's Gospel tells us that Jesus did this throughout Galilee.

Jesus' compassion and healing of the sick is a sign of the Kingdom of God. The Church continues to extend Christ's healing presence to others in its ministry to the sick. In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the Church prays for spiritual and physical healing, forgiveness of sins, and comfort for those who are suffering from illness.

In today's Gospel we also notice the importance of prayer in Jesus' daily life. Jesus rose early in the morning, removed himself from the crowds, and went to a deserted place to pray. When the disciples found him, he told them that it was time to move on. In his praying, Jesus sets us the example of the importance of seeking guidance and help from God. We also should bring our decision-making to God in prayer, asking for his inspiration and direction in our lives.
