

This weekend sees our First Holy Communion children being enrolled at Mass as they begin to prepare to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion. I would encourage everyone to pray for our children over the coming months as they prepare to deepen their personal encounter with Jesus as they receive him in the Blessed Sacrament.

Each of us can take to heart these two quotes. 'The Holy Eucharist is the gift that Jesus Christ makes of himself, thus revealing to us God's infinite love for every man and woman.' and 'In the Eucharist Jesus does not give us a "thing," but himself; he offers his own body and pours out his own blood'. Do we take that on as we come to Mass week by week and it that something that we can share with our young people at this important time of their lives? What a gift we can enjoy and share with others!
