For both schools, you must apply for a school place online. The online application process for Under 11s (Reception) commenced on Tuesday 1st November 2022 and will close on **Sunday 15th January 2023** on the following website www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/admissions

Reception 2023 applies to children born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019. As well as applying online to Hertfordshire you need to complete a **Supplementary Information Form** which should be sent into the office of the schools to which you are applying together with any supporting documentation.
