"The greatest among you must be your servant. All who exalt themselves will be humbled, and all who humble themselves will be exalted." The Gospel turns everything upside down — or should we say, it turns everything the right way up. The greatest is the least, by the very fact of thinking he's the greatest; and the least is the greatest, by the very fact of thinking he's the least.

For a Christian everything is on the ground. The word 'humility' comes from the Latin 'humus', which means earth. St Augustine said that God accepts sacrifices only from the altar of humility. Because everything is on the ground there are no bigwigs of any account. "Call no one on earth your father."
