TOWARDS OCTOBER 2024 - PARISH MEETING

The Diocese is asking us to prepare for the next stage of the ongoing Synod. Bishops and laypeople from around the world met in Rome for four weeks last October and considered all the submissions which had been sent in from the consultations which had been held last year. Two dominant themes of the Synthesis Report from the First Session were Co-responsibility and Formation. In preparation for the next session of the Synod, which will take place in Rome this coming October, we are being asked to consider how what was said about these two themes might inform a discussion about how, as a Parish, we might better organise ourselves for the mission of spreading the Good News of God's love for the world in our local area.
