Today is **Racial Justice Sunday**.

Racial Justice Sunday is an ecumenical observance which began in Britain and Ireland in 1995 following the murder of Stephen Lawrence, a black teenager in South London.

At Ss Peter & Paul we are very much a 'catholic' community, coming from different countries and cultures. Yet, what can really unite us is to be rooted in our common country – Heaven- and grow in our common culture - the Gospel.

On **Saturday 11th February**, World Day of the Sick, Memoria of Our Lady of Lourdes, there will be a Mass for the Sick at the Cathedral at 2.30pm, celebrated by the Cardinal, during which Anointing of the Sick will be offered.
