# PROPHETIC FAMILIES



Last month, Pope Francis spoke of a real "storm" threatening the Christian family and its mission as 'domestic Church' where the love of Christ, the fidelity of the Father and the bond of unity of the Holy Spirit finds a real home.

The Pope was speaking to the leaders of the *Équipes Notre-Dame*, a Movement born in France in the late 1930s, as a 'prophetic' word to face these big menacing "storms".

In the words of its founder, Père Henri Caffarel: *"the first meeting we had was very joyful (...) something happened that was not just a nice idea; it was something more than simple enthusiasm (...) our discussion led to a serious commitment to discover the plan of God for married couples in all the dimensions of their lives. We made a list of all the elements that make up the life of a couple and their family, we resolved to search what the will of God would be about all of those elements (...) their vocation was a call to holiness and that their holiness consisted in developing fully their love for each other and their love for Christ. This readiness of faith made them capable of understanding the sacrament of marriage in a whole new way. It was not a simple formality, but a prodigious source of Grace through which Christ comes to save love, grown sick since original sin, bringing help and enormous graces."*

-This morning at our 12noon Mass we have the joy to welcome some French speaking families of the *Équipes Notre-Dame* of London. If God wants, the call of the Pope for a "catechumenal" journey for married couples could find a home here in Clerkenwell soon...
