Extracts from the encyclical "Tutti Fratelli" - ON FRATERNITY AND SOCIAL FRIENDSHIP

Pope Francis

The different religions, based on their respect for each human person as a creature called to be a child of God, contribute significantly to building fraternity [...] Dialogue between the followers of different religions does not take place simply for the sake of diplomacy, consideration or tolerance. In the words of the Bishops of India, "the goal of dialogue is to establish friendship, peace and harmony, and to share spiritual and moral values and experiences in a spirit of truth and love"



At the same time, we ask God to strengthen unity within the Church, a unity enriched by differences reconciled by the working of the Spirit [....] As Saint Augustine said, "the ear sees through the eye, and the eye hears through the ear". It is also urgent to continue to bear witness to the journey of encounter between the different Christian confessions. [....] "even as we make this journey towards full communion, we already have the duty to offer common witness to the love of God for all people by working together in the service of humanity"
