"The Good Samaritan"

Today's Gospel is probably one of the best-known Gospel stories – and with good reason. It conveys a sense of both urgency and compassion. It also speaks of courage. Courage to do the right thing, even when that may appear difficult or inconvenient. It may be something simple like offering a smile or a greeting, or something practical. We are learning new ways of engaging with each other in the "new normal" in which we find ourselves. As St John Henry Newman put it, we should have "an eye on all our company".
