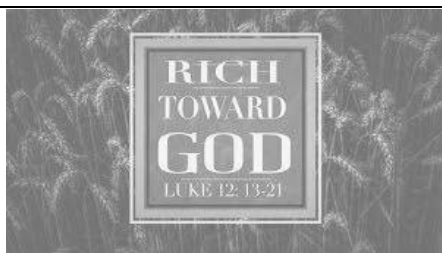

SUMMER TIME-TABLE

There will be no Saturday morning Mass from 9th July to 27th August. In August the Church will be closed Monday to Saturday except on Fridays when there will be a Eucharistic service at 9.30am followed by Eucharistic Adoration for one hour. The Sunday Masses will take place as usual at 9am and 11am, **no** Saturday 5pm Mass.
