

Pray Unceasingly

We are continuing to live through extraordinary times. The continuing war in Ukraine and the global consequences of the economic downturn are real and concerning. Sixty years ago, the world was in a similar position with the two superpowers, the Unites States and the Soviet Union engaged in a standoff, which could have seen the world changed beyond all recognition, had either side resorted to war... At that moment, the Bishops of the world gathered in Rome for the opening of the Second Vatican Council. It was a moment of grace, encounter and change, underpinned by prayer and an openness to grace.

This coming Tuesday, the Synthesis Document, following on from the initial part of the Synodal Pathway will be published. Each Diocese will be asked to share the findings from it. Again, this will be a moment for prayer and openness to grace. The Gospel this Sunday asks us to pray unceasingly. We can say a prayer at the beginning and end of our various tasks, which could be a starting point, knowing that God will answer our prayers – for ourselves and for the world – in the way that He sees as being best for us. Whatever we do, we should keep trying – trying to pray is praying!

Have a good week and let us pray for each other.

MASS OFFERINGS You are encouraged to book anniversary Masses etc. <u>AT LEAST three months</u> in advance to avoid disappointment. We recommend three Mass bookings per person at a time, so that everyone receives a fair chance to have Mass requests booked. As the Diocese suggests moving to a cashless system, wherever possible, all payments should be made online through bank transfer into parish account, quoting the reference "Mass Offering". REGISTRATION FOR SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMMES <u>ARE NOW CLOSED</u>. We are looking for volunteer catechists for this academic year, to assist in delivering the programmes. Thank you to those who served in this capacity and thank you in anticipation to those who will offer themselves for this very important ministry in the parish. Bejoy Ignatious will commence his role as a Pastoral Assistant from November.

MARRIAGE Couples seeking marriage should inform Fr John <u>AT LEAST six months</u> before the scheduled wedding date so that there is enough time for all the necessary administration work to be processed. This is a statutory requirement applicable across all parts of the UK and overseas.

SECONDARY SCHOOL SIGNING FORMS (CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE) If you have missed the assigned dates for CCP forms, please contact Fr John by email to make an appointment. You are encouraged to apply for more than one Catholic school, as the local schools around our area are often oversubscribed. Fr John is required to know the person for whom he is signing the form, so it is important that your child comes with you. There is a reasonable expectation for the parents to be practising Catholics and be supportive of the parish.
