### FR JOHN'S REFLECTION

#### This week's Gospel:

**John 10: 1-10**

This Sunday is **Good Shepherd Sunday**, when we read one of the much-loved passages in St John's Gospel, where Our Lord compares himself to a good or model shepherd and ourselves to the sheep of his flock. Because this picture of the good shepherd has been such a popular comparison for the role of the priest in the church. This Sunday has for many years been set aside as a day of prayer for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. So this weekend let us pray for all who are considering whether they may have such a vocation; that God will help them make their decision with a healthy combination of generosity and realisation. Please pray also for the men and women in seminaries and novitiates. Those who have made a provisional judgement about where their vocation lies, and are preparing to make a permanent commitment to that vocation and to exercise it. Pray for those who have been given the responsibility for promoting or testing vocations; a difficult and often unrewarding task. Above all, do try to deepen your own sense of vocation, because it is only when this is present in all of us that more people will respond to the call to the priestly ministry and to the religious life.
