#### MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

We have begun to think about the preparations we must make for the re-opening of our churches, even though it is still unclear precisely when this will happen. Meanwhile, we must continue to unite ourselves in prayer and with Christians throughout the world as we celebrate Trinity Sunday. In my note for the E-Alert I have tried to summarise the reflections I usually offer in my sermons at this weekend. But our second reading today (2 Corinthians 13: 11-13) is the closing words of Paul's second letter to the church at Corinth, and is a passage often used in Christian worship. We use it as one of the greetings at the beginning of Mass, and many prayer groups close their meetings by wishing each other 'The Grace'. We read it today because it is a text in which the gifts of Father, Son and Holy Spirit to the Christian are clearly stated.
