#### **MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN**

Many thanks to everyone who has already made donation to **CAFOD**, or undertaken fundraising initiatives. Our second reading today is again from the first letter of St Paul to the Corinthians, from an earlier part of the letter than the extracts we read a few weeks ago. Paul is reproaching his converts for allowing factions to form in the community, and for becoming conceited about the wisdom they think they possess. He declares that in the crucifixion of Christ, which he proclaims in his preaching, God has shown the foolishness of what the world counts as wisdom. His readers can only be truly wise if they make the cross of Christ the basis of their search for wisdom.
