HOLY WEEK & EASTER 2021

We recently received from the Diocese a document with directions on how the liturgies of the Easter weekend can be celebrated this year. We were relieved to find that most of these instructions were the same as the conclusions reached at a recent parish sub-committee meeting. Sadly, but not surprisingly, other traditional Holy Week events, such as the Good Friday Walk of Witness and Children's Stations of the Cross, will not be possible this year. Actions within the liturgies that involve close personal contact or present a risk of cross-infection, such as the Washing of Feet on Maundy Thursday and Veneration of the Cross on Good Friday, must also be omitted, although the meaning of these customs will remain very much in our thoughts. Subject to the availability of sufficient volunteer Stewards, Eucharistic Ministers and Readers, we hope to celebrate the following liturgies, which will be modified to comply with current restrictions.

- **Maundy Thursday: 1st April at 7.30pm – Mass of the Lord's Supper**
- **Good Friday: 2nd April at 3pm Liturgy of the Passion**
- **Holy Saturday: 3rd April at 8pm Mass of the Easter Vigil**
- **Easter Sunday: 4th April Mass at 10am**

MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

As always, our thanks to everyone who has made, or is about to make a donation to CAFOD, or to the Lenten Alms collection for the Cardinal's charities. But we would remind those of you who prefer to make your donation to either of these charities through the parish, to use one of the special envelopes for that charity. Our second reading is from a letter of St Paul from which we shall read many extracts later this year: the letter to the Ephesians. This letter reads like a definite statement of the teaching contained in Paul's other letters. Its main theme is the love of God for us his human creatures, which Paul compares to a free gift from a generous friend, and sums up the word we translate 'grace'. As the author of our first reading saw the love of God in the deliverance of the Jewish people from exile, so Paul sees the grace of God in the salvation brought by the death and resurrection of Jesus.
