MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

Renewed thanks to everyone who has made a donation to CAFOD or to the Lenten Alms collection for the Cardinal's charities. We would ask anyone who is about to make a donation to do so by next weekend, so that the offerings can be transferred to the charity by the requested date. Our thanks also to everyone who has volunteered to help at the liturgies of the Easter weekend. Full details of these are listed in this Newsletter – but booking is essential for all of them.

Our second reading is from the letter of St Paul to his converts in the northern Greek city of Philippi. In the section we read today Paul is exhorting his readers to be humble and considerate by quoting a hymn to Jesus. The hymn describes Our Lord's acceptance of suffering and death in words that recall the Suffering Servant depicted in our first reading. During Holy Week we accompany Jesus on his journey through death on the cross to what the hymn calls his 'Raising on High'.

Walk for Water

A message from Fabian Hiscock (our CAFOD Parish Representative & Deanery volunteer co-ordinator)

CAFOD is most grateful for your support in all the parishes, at what is recognised as a difficult time for many people and with so many competing calls, at home as in other parts of the world. Whatever is donated is being put to good use, especially in places like Ethiopia, and (with the Disasters and Emergencies Committee of which CAFOD is a member) to support the international Coronavirus response. But the need goes on: even in the last few days fighting in the Tigray province of Ethiopia has affected the community of Hagos, one of the people featured as a success in the Lent appeal for water, and much of the good has been undone: the work is not complete, and our Lent donations are needed. It will, of course, be some time before they can be assessed, but the early signs are promising. Thank you for all your support at a time of great need.

There are about 2000 people across the country doing the daily Walk of at least 10,000 steps in solidarity with those, especially in Ethiopia, who have no access to proper water supplies. I'm one, and I expect there are others in your parishes, although I'm not aware of them. People can still join in, even now, and CAFOD will be most grateful for any contributions they might raise.
