CHANGES TO COVID-19

PRECAUTIONS IN CHURCH

Following the Government's removal of all restrictions on 17th July, and guidelines received from the Diocese, the Parish Development Committee (PDC) met with Fr John to discuss the way forward. As a result, the changes listed below will take place with effect from this weekend, 24th/25th July.

• Booking system and seating plans for Mass to be withdrawn.

- Use of side aisles to be re-instated.
- Traditional ending of Mass to be resumed, with congregation approaching via centre aisle and returning to their seats after Communion via the side aisles.
- Fr John will resume administration of Communion, assisted by a Eucharistic Minister. One positioned at either side of the Sanctuary.
- Lighting of votive candles will now be permitted.
- Wall-mounted offerings boxes will be unsealed.
- QR codes will be displayed in the benches.
- 'Leave a Space' cards will be trialled to encourage safe distancing.
- Mass books available for use.

Remaining unchanged

- We will continue to have Stewards to monitor and guide.
- Use of alternate benches.
- Hand sanitisation on entry and exit.
- Face coverings requested.
- Communal singing remains suspended.
- Holy Communion under one kind.
- One way system to remain **for exit only**.
