MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

Many of you will have seen that Pope Francis has asked every diocese throughout the church to embark on a 'Synodal Path', to consider how to renew its mission after the pandemic. A Pastoral letter about how this will involve individual parishes is to be read at Mass this weekend.

Our second readings for the next seven Sundays are from the early part of the letter to the Hebrews. The author of this treatise does not name himself or the readers for whom he is writing, but scholars have inferred from its contents that he was writing for Jews who had been converted to faith in Jesus, but felt nostalgia for the worship at the Jerusalem Temple.

At the beginning of the letter the author declares that Jesus is superior to all who came before him in the revelation God made to Israel. The author quotes a passage from the psalms to present Jesus as the one who was lower than the angels for a short time, but is now crowned with splendour. Then, in the passage we read today, he emphasises that Jesus reached this exalted state only after tasting death for mankind. Jesus could be the pioneer of our salvation because he was of the same stock as the brothers he sanctified.

ASSISTED DYING BILL 2021

Message from Bishop John Sherrington

This October, an 'Assisted Dying' Bill will be debated in the House of Lords. If successful it will allow a terminally ill adult with less than 6 months to live, assistance to commit suicide. The Catholic Church teaches that this represents a crime against human life, we cannot directly choose to take the life of another, even if they request it. The Bishops therefore urge you to **PRAY** this Bill is defeated, **WRITE** to Peers and MPs expressing concern about this proposed legislation and **SHARE** our resources and those of our allies, in the weeks ahead with family and friends, especially via social media.
