MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

This weekend we are celebrating the last of the baptisms of the children whose baptisms were delayed by the pandemic. Next Sunday, at 10am Mass, we hope to celebrate the full Sacraments of Initiation for a couple who have been regular members of our congregation, but whose baptism has also been delayed until now. We congratulate all these new members of our community, and welcome them to play their full part in the life of the parish.

The second reading this week is our second from the letter of St James. This document is attributed to the relative of Jesus who became the head of the Christian community at Jerusalem and was executed in 62AD. Many scholars believe that the letter was compiled by an admirer of St James, perhaps thirty years after his death. We noted last week that the document reads like a collection of sermon notes, and the author's attack on social discrimination in the Christian community has been applied to many situations in church life.
