MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

Renewed congratulations to our neighbours in the Anglican parish of All Saints, as they celebrate the 150th anniversary of their foundation this year; and our congratulations to the members of the Flower Team, who made such a fine contribution to the Flower Festival at All Saints Church last weekend.

Our second reading this weekend is our third extract from the letter of St Paul to the Colossians. Two weeks ago we read the hymn that Paul quoted to show Jesus Christ as supreme in God's creation and head of the church. Now Paul warns his readers not to be captivated by what he calls 'hollow speculation, not based on Christ'. Paul emphasises that it is through baptism and faith in Christ that we gain true life and the forgiveness of our sins. Any powers that seemed to control the material world had been defeated by the death and resurrection of Christ, so there was no need to placate them.
