My renewed thanks to all who have supported me during my recent illnesses, and to all who have ensured that our basic parish services have continued to be supplied during the holiday period. I hope you have had, or will be having, a refreshing holiday during this time.

Our second readings for the next two Sundays come from the final part of the letter to the Hebrews. The author is exhorting his readers to persevere in their faith in Jesus. He sees the suffering of Christians as part of the training imposed by God the Father, whom he compares to a human father training his children. In the passage we read next weekend, he compares the gathering of the Jewish nation on Mount Sinai with the gathering of the church in heaven.
