MESSAGE FROM FR JOHN

As the commercial world has been reminding us, next Monday is Halloween, the eve of the feast of All Saints. Our Mass on Tuesday will be that of All Saints. As Wednesday is All Souls Day, I shall also say Mass at 10am that morning, so that we can commemorate the faithful departed on the traditional date. Our second readings for the next three Sundays are from the second letter of St Paul to the Thessalonians. The first letter Paul wrote to the Christians in Thessalonika is generally thought to be the earliest document in the New Testament. In it Paul had written about the 'Day of the Lord' on which Jesus would come in glory to judge the world and bring this age to a close. But in this letter Paul warns his readers not to behave as if the 'Day of the Lord' had already happened. They must not give up the work by which they earn their living.
