The second readings on the next two Sundays are again from the shorter of the letters attributed to St Paul and addressed to St Timothy. #### DATE FOR YOUR DIARY Parish Gardening Day

Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> October – 10am Our annual tidy-up before the winter, with refreshments provided for the workers! This is what we hope to achieve:

- Remove foliage growth across door to tool shed.
- Removal of ash tree saplings (may need to identify and carry forward).
- Prune rose bushes.
- Trim high level hedges.
- Trim back over grown shrubs especially round the back of the Sacristy.
- Trim back shrubs that are obscuring windows.
- Remove ivy clinging to any walls, shed/garage roof, gate posts at entrance.
- Cut back overhanging brambles.
- Trim back overhanging trees adjacent to fire exit and brick shed.

We have some gardening equipment, but feel free to bring your own if there is a particular task you would like to take on. *Please help if you can.*
