Our second reading on Palm Sunday is from the letter of St Paul to his converts in the northern Greek city of Philippi. In the section we read this weekend, Paul is exhorting his readers to be humble and considerate by quoting a hymn to Jesus. The hymn describes Our Lord's acceptance of suffering and death in words that recall the Suffering Servant described in our first reading. During Holy Week we accompany Jesus on his journey through death on the cross to what the hymn calls his 'Raising on High'.
