## PRIESTS TRAINING FUND COLLECTION

There are currently 48 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 14 of whom are from our own Diocese, as well as two men studying in Rome, and two in Valladolid. ## ST BEDE'S GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE

We are very fortunate to have our Garden of Remembrance, where the ashes of loved ones may be interred. At the time of interment. the ashes only are reverently poured into the vault during a short prayer service – we regret that caskets/urns cannot be stored there. It has been customary for flowers, plaques, figurines and other ornaments to be placed in the vicinity of the vault, in remembrance of loved ones interred there. However, in order to preserve the dignity and beauty of the interment area, and to give due respect to those whose ashes have already been placed there, it has been necessary to define a number of rules and regulations. In the coming months we plan to refurbish the Garden of Remembrance, and replace the existing tributes placed there with an alternative mark of respect possibly a purpose built notice board with small name plagues.
