This newsletter is prepared before the weekend, but we may surely thank in advance all who will be representing the parish by serving on the St Bede's stall at the Croxlev Revels, and everyone who is helping to support them. In our Liturgy this weekend we return to the Mass texts provided for the 'Sundays in Ordinary Time', and as you will see above, this Sunday is the 'Eleventh Sunday of the Year'. For the next few months, at our Sunday Masses, we study extracts from the gospel of St Matthew, and from the most important of St Paul's letters; his letter to the church of Rome. The passages we hear this weekend and next are from the most discussed part of that letter.

SPONSOR A KNEELER

PARISH LIFE
