CAFOD – Summer Campaign FIX THE FOOD SYSTEM Many thanks to all who signed our large letter/petition last weekend. Please pray for the success of this campaign.

There are increasing concerns about the power of the few huge international corporations which dominate the global food system and the small farmers who actually produce a large part of the world's food. Globally, just nine crops account for over 65% of all crop production, and are largely traded and transported by a few large businesses. Small farmers are increasingly unable to get the wide range of local seed varieties they've used, often for generations, and have to use the limited and often unsuitable seeds, needing chemical fertilisers and pesticides, from a few large providers. And this constraint is supported by the policies of the World Bank. Salina, a small farmer in Bangladesh, has written to the World Bank calling for protection for the fundamental rights of smallscale farmers to use their own varieties of resilient seeds. And CAFOD is leading an effort in this country to allow us all to add our names to Salina's letter. More information available at: https://cafod.org.uk/campaign/fi x-the-food-system
